Nathalie Hoffman, CEO of LCFS Consulting Services, Inc. to Speak at the FEW Low Carbon Fuel Production Workshop

American biofuels producers are always looking for ways to diversify their sources of revenue, and these days it's more important than ever. That's why the passage of Brazil's new RenovaBio law brings good news for the US corn ethanol industry.

The law is analogous to the LCFS. Both seek to incentivize the reduction of GHG from on-road transportation and are technology and fuel neutral. Both require the producer to determine the carbon intensity (CI) on a pathway-by-pathway basis, and each uses a life cycle analysis model to do so. Each compares the pathway's CI with that of the CI of the fossil fuel it replaces. Finally, each requires the pathway to be certified by implementing agency before it can reap the financial benefit.



RenovaBio's incentive is in the form of publicly traded securities called Cbios. It's worth noting that the law expressly permits US corn ethanol to generate them.

A certified LCFS verifier, Ms. Hoffman is uniquely qualified to speak about RenovaBio. She lived in Brazil and is a fluent Portuguese speaker, having spent substantial time in the Brazilian ethanol sector. Besides RenovaBio, she is an expert on the LCFS.

Her talk is entitled *Diversifying Your Revenue Stream: Cbios, Brazil's Counterpart to LCFS Credits*, and it will take place on **Tuesday, September 15th, at 8:30 AM CST.**
